


艺术



Look at these two paintings. What are the main differences between the two? What feelings do you think the artists are trying to express in each one?



The biggest difference between the two paintings may be a surprise to you: one of them was painted by a lion! Many animals are able to paint, and some are even becoming famous. In 2012, an exhibition in London showed art by monkeys, elephants, and big cats. In 2014, an elephant named Phoolkali was the star of its own show, with visitors giving over \$400 to buy a Phoolkali painting!

Some people say that paintings by animals are not proper art because animals aren't really creative. But animal art is certainly popular, and sometimes people are unable to tell if a painting was made by a person or a lion. Do you know which one is which?

1. Which painting do you think was painted by a lion? Why?
2. Would you go to an exhibition of animal art?
3. Do you think that art by animals is real art? Why or why not?
